Grade One is a special year! We will be emphasizing some basic skills for life-long learning. The following categories will be our priorities:

Birthday Invitations

Please NO birthday invitations to school, as it can be difficult for children this age to understand that it is not possible to invite everyone from the class. If you do send invites to school, please give them to Mrs. Malo to be given discretely.

Attendance

Parents are asked to contact the school by phone, and send a dated/signed note if your child is going to be picked up by someone other than yourself (Grandma, Auntie), or if your child has an appointment. Please check in with the office when picking up for an appointment and returning to school from appointments.

Medical

Please inform me immediately if your child has any allergies or health concerns, please remember to also complete forms with information regarding these concerns.

<u>Shoes</u>

Please ensure your child has an <u>INDOOR</u> pair of shoes (<u>Gym use: Velcro/non marking soles).</u> Students are expected to remove outdoor shoes after entering class.

Classroom Rules/Expectations

Home/School Communication

End of Day/PICK UP: You will find HOME/BUS/AFTERSCHOOL card(s) in your child's communication bag. HOME WORK

In the first week of school, your child will learn how to use Seesaw (learning platform). I will also send Home login information. There will be a home assignment on **Seesaw** each week I will email to notify parents once this begins.

Home Reading: I encourage you to enjoy books with your child each day. There is an online program called Raz-Kids that you will be able to access with your child. The information about how to log on to the program will be coming home soon. When you use the Raz-Kids online reading program, you are always able to access suitable books for your child. I will also be able to check on your child's progress. Of course, your child may choose to read a book outside of Raz-Kids as well. Feel free to access books from the public library or use your own "at home library". More information regarding our Home Reading program will be coming soon.

<u>Sight Words</u>: We will be practicing the sight words together as a class to begin with. I will send a list of words along with the Home Reading for your child to focus on near the end of this month.

Homework continued

Spelling tests: Spelling will begin at the end of October. More information will be sent home in October.

Projects and Show and Tell: Information will be sent home with your child and by email in advance of the due date.
